§ 1 - Subject of Contract

The subject of this contract is the author's / the authors' work, already produced or about to be produced, bearing the following title:

§ 2 - Concession of rights

The author(s) are joint and otherwise exclusive proprietors of all rights to the work. They transfer to the publisher, without any limitation as to country of publication, and for the period to which copyright legally applies, the exclusive right to reproduce and distribute (under the German laws of publishing) the work detailed in § 1 in the conference proceedings

together with any figures contained in the work, for all versions and editions, without limitation as to number of copies, and for all languages. They guarantee that sale of the work will infringe neither the rights nor the claims of any third party, and that he/she/they has/have not exercised the rights in respect of the work in any other way, whether in whole or in part. In particular, the author/authors assigns/assign the following rights of use over the work to the publisher, without limitation as to time, place or content:
