- 3. **Team introduction:** Who are you? What makes you special as a team? What is each of you an expert in? What resources do you possibly already bring to the start-up project?
- 4. **Expectations of the class:** What do the team want from the programme and the coaches? Where do you need special support? What are you most looking forward to?
- 5. Vision: What do you want to achieve after the Ilmkubator Class? Where will you be with your project in two years from today?
