 - Financial support



Maximum funding period for Erasmus stays

Students: During studies up to 12 months / 24 months *

- per program of higher education, e.g.
 - Bachelor
 - Master
 - PhD
 - *single subject program (State exam | Diploma)

- **12** e.g. 6 months of studies | 6-month traineeship
- **12** e.g. 6 months of studies | 3-month traineeship | 3-month traineeship
- **12** e.g. 12-month traineeship
- **24** e.g. 12 months of studies | 12-month traineeship

Graduates: After graduation up to 12* months

After graduation

- **12** e.g. 6-month traineeship within the degree program | 6-month traineeship after graduation
- ! Application and selection required prior to graduation
- ! Traineeship within 12 months after graduation
- ! Note Zero-Grant regulation for financial support.

- Social partners or other representatives of the labour market, e.g. chambers of commerce
- Career counselling and information centers
- Embassies or consulates of the Erasmus program countries

Not eligible for funding are traineeships in

- EU bodies and institutions
- Institutions managing EU programs

Financial Support

Zero-Grant



- Financial support is temporary
- Periods beyond are not financially supported (= Zero Grant)



TO DO

Job search

- Search for a trainee position
- Assistance by university professors, fellow students, trade press, company contact fairs, EU-Praktikum THÜRINGEN, when required

Also possible without trainee position

Application

- Online form www.eu-praktikum.de
- Recommended 4 months before planned start
- Deadline: 2 months prior to the start
- With CV, enrollment certificate, letter of recommendation

Organization

- e.g. accommodation, travel, insurance, personal preparation, ...
- Your copay in funding(!)
- Online language service of EU Academy
- Information about the situation in the host country before departure (pandemics, conflicts), arrangement with university

Procedure

Prior to the traineeship

- Learning Agreement
- Grant Agreement with insurance declaration
- Access to EU Academy

During the traineeship

- Amendment of the Learning Agreements
- Contact person in the traineeship

After the traineeship

- Learning Agreement:
 Confirmation and recognition of traineeship
- Evaluation
- Europass Mobility



Information for international students

- Check/Approval with the Alians Office about residence permit in Germany
 - Residence permit expires after 6-month stay abroad
 - Up to 120 working days per year possible (compulsory traineeships are additional)
 - For graduates
 - Up to 18 month job search
 - Aim is employment as a specialist in Germany
 - Approval of the Federal Employment Agency for internships abroad
- REST Directive (EU) 2016/801
 - Traineeships as a part of a degree programme at a German university in Schengen countries possible without visa
 - Comply with the host country's reporting obligations
