

First steps ...

for a good start to your studies at TU Ilmenau.

Please follow the steps outlined **in the order given**.

The QR codes next to the explanations of each step lead to websites with further information.

Step 1 : Student ID thoska

As a first-year student, you can receive your thoska student ID card at the Base Camp. The Base Camp is temporarily located in the Ernst-Abbe-Zentrum (EAZ) room 1341 Ehrenbergstrasse 29, centrally located on the TU Ilmenau campus.



Option : Residential home on campus

If you have concluded a contract with Studierendenwerk Thüringen for the use of a residential home on campus, then activate your thoska as a key and take over your place in the residential home. The contact details and office hours of your janitor and the person responsible for your case at Studierendenwerk Thüringen can be found in the Rental Portal. You can also find the office hours of your janitor directly at the office in your residential home.



Step 2 : Uni-Account

The Uni-Account activation in the Onboarding Portal enables you to use the IT services of the University Computing Center. After logging on with your Uni-Account (username and password) you have access to the following portals.

Step 3 : MFA

Registration for multi-factor authentication in the MFA Portal is a prerequisite for generating a one-time password. You will need the one-time password in addition to your Uni-Account (username and password) when logging in to selected portals.

Step 4 : WLAN

The TUIL wireless LAN provides wireless access to the TUIL data network and the Internet. You must activate your Uni-Account to use the TUIL WLAN.

The TUIL WLAN is available under the name eduroam.

With each re-registration for the following semester, the registration certificate is updated according to the semester.

Step 8 : Curricula

Step 10 : Student Office

The employees at the Student Office are the point of contact for all questions regarding the formal organisation of the study, also welcome during [consultation hours at the ASC](#).



Step 11 : Exam Offices

The [registration](#) for students at the University Library allows you to use the services of the University Library.
