



Call for Germany's Scholarship at the Technische Universität Ilmenau

In the academic year 2023/2024, the Technische Universität Ilmenau awards Germany's Scholarships (Deutschland-stipendium) according to federal procurement directives and depending on the funds available (up to 45). The awarding of the scholarship is based on the Federal Scholarship Program Act (Stipendienprogrammgesetz StipG), the appropriate federal scholarship program regulation (Stipendienprogrammverordnung StipV) and the statutes and funding guidelines of Ilmenau University of Technology referring to Germany's Scholarship (DstipFöRiLi TU IL)). The scholarship amount is 300 euro per month. Students studying at Ilmenau University of Technology and applicants who have decided to study at Ilmenau University of Technology can apply for the scholarship. Application term runs from May 15 to June 30, 2023. Enrollment in the applicant portal and document upload will be possible from June 12, 2023.

The following documents are to be provided - Pay attention to §5 paragraph 2 DStipFöRiL):

- cv in tabular form
- Certificate of enrollment for the upcoming winter semester

The time of study mentioned in the following refers to the coming winter semester.

- for applicants in the first and second Bachelor semester: Certificate of university entrance qualification, Abiturzeugnis* (If applicable, proof of a special qualification within the meaning of Section 2 (1) No. 1b StipG that entitles you to study at the TU Ilmenau,)
- for applications from the third Bachelor semester: Examination results and ECTS at the TU Ilmenau
- for applicants in the first or second master's semester: Bachelor's certificate, proof of admission according to §§ 4, 5 of the master's examination regulations general provisions of the TU Ilmenau (aptitude test for MA students),
- for applications form the third semester Master's semester: Examination results and ECTS at the TU Ilmenau
- completely filled out and signed application form (in Mobility Online)

if applicable

- proof of previous academic achievements,
- internship certificates and testimonials (referring to previous activities or activities, accompanying the study program)
- proof of extracurricular activities and commitments (active participation in associations or boards and committees),
- proof of special awards / prizes,
- proof of particular family-related and personal circumstances (e.g. birth certificates of own children, proof of being caregiver to family members; medical certificate indicating chronic illness and supporting documents relating to disabilities respectively, status of an asylum-seeker or asylum authorisation),
- proof any other requested or granted support / funding,
- proof of any previous relation of a Germany scholarship (is not valid for subsequent application)

The following documents are to be submitted for an application for continued scholarship:

- completely filled out digital form (in Mobility Online) with all required documents and certificates,
- certificate of matriculation (as far as it is available by the end of the deadline for application),
- brief report (max. 1 DIN-A-4 page) on the development in the previous scholarship period including any extracurricular activities,
- proof of examination results and any other achieved study results, internships, semesters / internships abroad that inform about the performance quality in the previous scholarship period.







Selection procedure

The selection decision on the scholarship holders to be supported is made by the study committee. The decision on the sponsorship is based on the following selection criteria according to § 3 StipG in conjunction with § 2 StipV as well as § 6 Para. 2 of the sponsorship guidelines for the awarding of German scholarships at the TU Ilmenau:

- Performance and talent in accordance with § 2 Praa. 1 StipV; Merit Scholarship
- prior professional activities / internships
- extracurricular activities
- employment accompanying the course of studies
- particular success, awards and prizes
- taking care of one's own children and other dependent persons
- Status of an asylum-seeker or asylum authorisation
- chronic illnesses and disabilities
- parents' educational attainment
- previous granting of Germany's scholarship (Deutschlandstipendium) at Technische Universität Ilmenau

The decision on granting the scholarship is based on the consideration of the mentioned criteria according to the evaluation system valid at the university. Only complete applications will be considered for selection.

Granting the scholarship

Information on the approval of a Deutschlandstipendium will be provided in mid-October.

The scholarship is granted for two semesters (duration of the scholarship). Before the period expires, a new application for subsequent granting of the scholarship can be submitted within the new application period. The scholarship can only be granted by the end of the standard study period (Regelstudienzeit), which is the maximum support period (Förderungshöchstdauer). According to § 4 StipG, Germany's scholarship (Deutschlandstipendium) is not granted in case of any other skills or performance related scholarships provided by other institutions (exclusion of double funding). This decision does not apply to grants of 30 euro per month (minor limit). The scholarship is only granted when the certificate of enrollment for the requested period is submitted by 15. October at the latest.

Payment of the scholarship

Payment is made as soon as and to the extent of the availability of sufficient public and private scholarship funding. Based on the awarding decision, the scholarship is paid in monthly allocations always monthly from the beginning of the period granted. The scholarship is paid independently and does not refer to any income or the parents of the student in question, and it does not influence the amount of BaföG paid.

The first payment will be made retrospectively in **December** - after the awards ceremony in **November**.

It is expected that the grantees will attend 1-2 events in the form of grantee meetings or other participate in events of the scholarship system per semester.
