

SUBMISSION OF THE FINAL THESIS at the Department of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology

You are expected to submit your final thesis in a bound form in triplicate to the Examination Office of the Department of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology. The structure of your thesis should have the following order:

- **Cover sheet**
- Statement of Thanks (possible)
- Table of contents
- Introduction
- Main part
- Summary
- Bibliography
- List of symbols and abbreviations used
- Appendix (laboratory reports, programs, extensive additional consideration, ...)
- **Declaration of Originality (signed)**
- Possible Rights of confidentiality
- Possible Agreement on the rights of exploitation (copy)
- **electronic form (CD)**

Furthermore, you need to submit the following documents:

1. **Confirmation of the abstract issued by the University Library**

 - Abstracts are reported in German and English according to PO-AB
 - The content of the abstract requires the approval of the academic advisor of the Technische Universität Ilmenau.

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2. **Application for/Minutes of the Diploma /Bachelor /Master's procedure**
Document name: Antrag/Protokoll Diplom-/Bachelor-/Masterverfahren
3. **Remark of discharge of the supervising group**
Document name: Entlastungsvermerk Fachgebiet
4. **Registration form for study-related stays abroad**

You can submit your final thesis at the Examination Office of the Department of Electrical Engineering and Information Technology (Kirchhoffbau, room K2079) by appointment or during the opening times.

Please mind that if you are leaving the Technische Universität Ilmenau you additionally need to fill and hand in the application of exmatriculation.

GENERAL INFORMATION for the final thesis

- The form of the final thesis should meet the current DIN-regulations.
- If the submission date falls on a weekend or celebration day, the next following working day will be the submission day.
- The topic - together with a written statement - can be returned to the examination board once within the first four weeks of the processing period in the case of a Bachelor's thesis, and within the first eight weeks in the case of a Master's thesis.
- The processing period can be prolonged by the examination committee by no more than 3 months on the written reasonable request of the student (Master EIT: maximum 2 month).
- The mandatory colloquium is supposed to take place within 4 weeks after the submission of the final thesis.
- If the student fails to submit the final thesis in time, it will be marked "not sufficient".

Please mind the binding regulations Examination Regulations - General Provisions as well as Examination Regulations - Specific Provisions.
