In 2014 the German-Russian Institute of Advanced Technologies (GRIAT) was founded in Kazan, the capital of the autonomous Republic of Tatarstan. The project offers engineering master courses according to German education standards at the **Kazan National Research Technical University "Tupolev"**. (KNRTU-KAI). GRIAT is a structural subdivision of KNRTU-KAI.

- Double Degree = two master diplomas, one from KNRTU- KAI Kazan and one from the German partner universities
