

### Key data „Corona summer semester 2020“

- ▶ The summer semester takes place regularly from 1 April 2020 to 30 September 2020.
- ▶ The lecture period ends on 17 July 2020.
- ▶ The examination period is extended from 20 July to 30 September 2020.
- ▶ Registration for examinations in this period will take place from 1 to 8 July 2020.
- ▶ Online teaching with exam-relevant content has taken place since 20 April 2020. Limited face-to-face teaching started on 4 May 2020.
- ▶ There are flexible arrangements for students who cannot travel to Ilmenau or who have difficulties in participating in the e-learning offers.
- ▶ Special regulations, e.g. on the standard period of study and examinations, are laid down in the [Statute on Special Provisions due to the SARSCoV-2 Pandemic 2020](#).

### Online Teaching

- ▶ Lectures and seminars will take place until 17 July 2020 as e-learning offers, as far as possible.
- ▶ Information on the e-learning offers is provided on the [faculties' websites](#).
- ▶ Live streams of online courses will take place only during the actual lecture times.

### Face-to-face Courses

- ▶ Courses which require special laboratory or work rooms may take place face-to-face in compliance with the [infection prevention concept](#).
- ▶ Face-to-face courses are listed in the [e-calender of events \(Open Time Table\)](#).
- ▶ Limited access to the University Library is available.

### Examinations

- ▶ will generally take place face-to-face in compliance with the [infection prevention concept](#).
- ▶ Please note the [special protection and hygiene measures](#) in connection with the examinations.
- ▶ During the examination period exams may take place between Monday to Saturday 7 a.m. - 9 p.m.
- ▶ By agreement between the examiner and the student, alternative dates for final examinations which could not be taken in the winter semester 2019/20 can also be arranged during the lecture period of the summer semester.

### Infection Prevention Measures on Site

- ▶ Keep a general minimum distance of 1.5 m
- ▶ Wash hands regularly with liquid soap
- ▶ Ensure adequate room ventilation
- ▶ Splitting of groups for face-to-face courses
- ▶ Sick persons are to be excluded from face-to-face events
